Every year, hundreds of wild birds become tangled in discarded fishing line and litter associated with this activity. Though many anglers take their litter home, there are clearly a large number who don't given the clear evidence left behind. This costs rescuers and rehabilitators a great deal of time and expense, and can cause serious injury or death to the birds themselves.
